THREE NEW GRANTS OPEN THIS MONTH

The Moose International Board of Directors approved three new grant programs for the 2024-25 fiscal year, and all three applications are scheduled to open next month.

- **Lodge Grants** (infrastructure and improvements) \$1.5M available to be granted, up from \$1M the past two years. Grants are obtainable up to \$25,000 per lodge. <u>Applications open on Monday</u>, July 8 and close Friday, August 9.
- Local Marketing Grants \$500,000 available to lodges for the third straight year. Grants are obtainable up to \$3,000 per lodge. Applications open on Tuesday, July 30 and close at the end of the fiscal year or when funds run out, whichever is sooner.
- NEW Lodge Signage Grants \$1M available to update, replace or refurbish lodge signs. Grants are obtainable up to \$3,000 per lodge. Applications open on Tuesday, July 30 and close at the end of the fiscal year or when funds run out, whichever is sooner.

Requirements for all of the grant programs remain the same:

At least one member of the lodge is required to attend the International Moose Convention in New Orleans in July.

At least one member of the lodge was required to be attendance at the lodge's 2023 Association Annual Convention in the Fall; and at least one member of the lodge was required to attend the lodge's 2024 Association Midyear Conference in the Spring.

Lodge must be in good standing and run as a fraternal operation.

All grant applications can be accessed by lodge administrators at LCL.web. Information on all the grant programs can be found on the Moose International website (www.mooseintl.org) and through Official Communications sent to each lodge.
