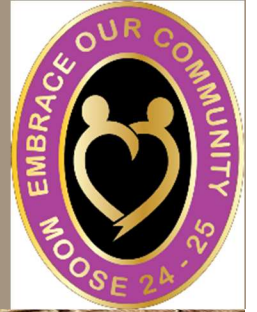
WOTM members!!
