There will be snacks!



This voluntary program was created to exclusively meet our Lodge's basic overhead costs. With our basic liabilities being met, it will enable our Lodge to better serve its members, Mooseheart, Moosehaven and our community.

After much consideration, the following donation amounts have been determined to meet those liabilities based on one hundred participating members. Members may choose monthly payments of \$22, bi-annual payments of \$130 or a single payment of \$250.

After one year's membership in the program the individual's yearly Lodge and Moose Legion dues will be paid for by the Lodge.

The Lodge Guardian Committee, as all Lodge committees, must report at each Lodge membership meeting income and expenditures.

Currently Lodge Guardian funds are paying the annual Lodge personal property insurance, phone, cable, internet, bank fees, garbage and recycling for the next 12 months.

#### Lodge Plus One Incentive Offer

The Moose Intl. Board of Directors has approved a new incentive for fiscal year 2024-25 that will rebate \$38 of dues paid to Moose Intl. for every member over the Lodge's final active member count from fiscal year ending on April 30, 2025.

For example, if a Lodge has 100 members on that date and its active member count in April 30, 2025 is 115, the Lodge would receive a credit of \$570 which would go towards the Lodge's Moose Intl. Accounts Receivable.

By achieving a gain of 30+ members, the Lodge will receive a check following the end of this next fiscal year. There is no limit to the number of rebates the Lodge can receive. We started this year with 159 members, we got this!

## No Application Fee May 1-Dec. 31, 2024

The \$20 application fee will be waived for new (enrolled or re-enrolled) applicants paying 2 years of Lodge dues using the online application only.

We hope this will not only promote and encourage use of the available technology, but encourage member production, giving the Lodge an extended opportunity to showcase the benefits of Moose Lodge Membership to include our fraternal endeavors as well as the local Lodge amenities.
