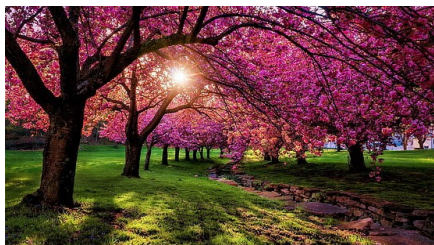

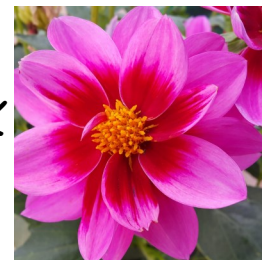
If you have something that could help the lodge look better or a dinner idea we are all ears.
