- \*All posted days and times are subject to change with notice and exclude observed holidays.*

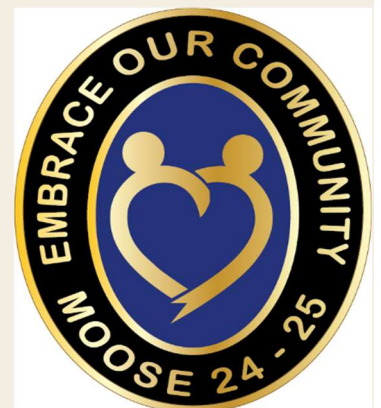
## Rent the hall!

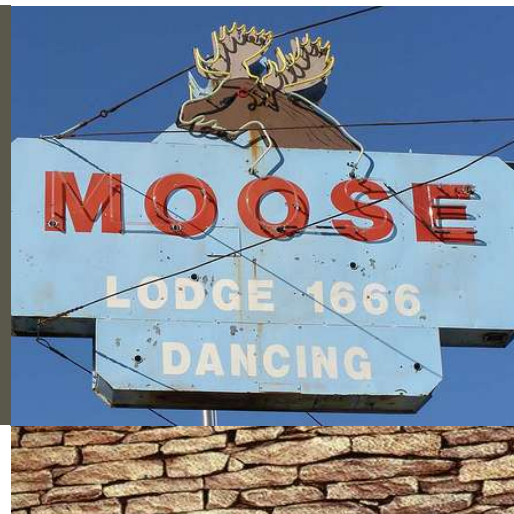
